





Pilot Officer Vivian Evelyn Lower


Vivian Lower was born in Edmonton in May 1912 to parents Nynian Evelyn Lower and Edith Grave Lower Nee Morley

He attended Lords William's School Thame and flew in the Royal Air Force as aircrew; 143871.

He was part of the crew of a 224 Squadron Consolidated Liberator IV that left the RAF station at St Eval on Biscay patrol at 04.11 hrs on 2nd September 1943. At 09.33hrs they reported enemy aircraft and following this nothing more was heard from them.

At the probate of his will in July 1944 his address is given as 141 Manor Green-road, Epsom, Surrey.

His name is commemorated on the Air Forces Memorial at Runnymede in Surrey and is remembered in Thame on the Lord Williams's School Memorial Board.
